On Monday, our Head boy (Kiyan) and Head girl (Faith) will be in charge of the school including greeting you and your children on the door and delivering assembly.

Also next week: Form 5 will be sitting their Mock exams at Hartley Hall on Monday. Form 6 continue their Healthy minds program on Monday and Forest School on Tuesday. On Wednesday, Form 6 will be continuing their Holocaust Education sessions and Upper School will be practising Sports Day in the afternoon and Thursday 7th July is the School Sponsored Walk afternoon.

Wednesday is our whole school transition day – Upper school children will meet their new teachers in the morning from 10.30 – 12.00 and Lower School will meet their new teachers in the afternoon. We are welcoming parents in to meet their child's new teacher from 3.45 followed by an invitation to view the children's work from our Spirited Arts project in our exhibition - taking place in the Form 3 and Form 6 classrooms and also in EYFS. Parents of siblings are welcome to drop in to talk to multiple teachers after the initial presentation. The new Form 5 'meet the teacher' will also include information about their residential in September including a kit list. All information will be shared on the parent website area afterwards and important curriculum information will, of course, be shared again in September.

Parking – Mrs Mbah has asked that parents please, please, please be considerate to our neighbours when parking and do not block their drives. This behaviour (and potential adult exchange of words it may cause) does not reflect our school values and gives a negative model to our pupils, not least your own child. We are very aware that this is causing some tension and we are asking all parents to be respectful when parking as well as supremely polite when dealing with our neighbours. Additionally, we are speaking to our neighbours to ask them to be polite in their handling of this problem, however, they are understandably, collectively frustrated. We recognise that this is sadly a minority of parents affecting the reputation of you, our parents and our school. Senior leadership team spend a vast amount of time dealing with insensitive parking and neighbour complaint - we would much rather be using this time to further develop your child's education.
