This Week

On Tuesday, we celebrated Kodomo no Hi, Children's Day - a Japanese festival to bring good luck, health and happiness to all children for the year ahead. The children enjoyed learning about the symbolism of koi carp, samurai helmets and special desserts in the assembly. The lower school had fun colouring in their koi fish drawings whilst the upper school tried their hands at making origami helmets and writing in Japanese kanji!

Form 6 have had an amazing time on their outdoor adventure trip to PGL, taking part in all sorts of activities including: high ropes, buggy building, archery, fencing, climbing, rafting, shooting, shelter making, camp fire, team building and problem solving.

Form 5 have been writing informative pieces of writing about climate change including: podcasts, documentaries, newspaper articles, PowerPoints, news reports, mini books and even an encyclopaedia renamed as an Eco-paedia!

Form 4 have been enjoying their 'Local History' topic. They have looked into the area's rich history of aeronautical engineering, particularly the vast expanse of factories previously on Edgware Road. They have chosen an area to independently research further including: the very first hot air balloon, Edward Elliott and the Curtis Wright CW12 Bi-Plane, the Grey and White XIII built in Mill Hill, the Lewis Blerist XI - which was the first aeroplane to cross the channel to France.

Form 3 have been continuing their study of Beowolf by listening to songs from different characters and writing from the perspective of different characters, producing comics, letters or diaries. They have also written instruction and entertaining texts in the form of spells, poems, instructions and recipes.

Having read their core text, 'The bee who spoke', Form 2 have been writing pieces to convince Mrs Doherty which of their items is best – treehouse, hobbyhorse or easel and explaining what they would pack in their own suitcase and why as well as planning with detailed labelled drawings their mini-beast artwork and making these from Fimo.

Form 1 have been continuing their writing in other lessons this week too by writing their version of 'The Very Hungry Caterpillar' in French. This helped them to consolidate their learning about the names of fruit and days of the week. They also typed elements of their core text 'Town mouse and Country mouse' with a focus on understanding the text toolbar (Bold, Italics, text colour etc) space bar, delete and how to create a capital letter.

EYFS have also been practising their writing in a variety of ways including: hand strengthening exercises, name writing, lego writing, lists, exciting words, 'magic' crayon writing appearing with paint, sand, foam, and stories.

Next Week

Form 6 are taking part in Bikeability sessions throughout the week, beginning with exercising control and accuracy on the playground leading up to safe travel on the local roads.

The Healthy School Council will be delivering their Sun Safety Assembly on Monday.

The School Council will be helping us to think about Mental Health Awareness Week. The national theme for this year is anxiety and we have attached a leaflet for further information on this topic.

On Monday, Form 6 will be learning about 'Healthy Minds'.

On Tuesday, Form 1 and 2 will be on their trip to Barnet Environmental Centre.

On Wednesday, EYFS are visiting the local shops including the greengrocers, to look at fruit and veg and consider healthy eating choices.

On Thursday, EYFS have their final 'come learn with me session' and Form 5 will be supporting our local community by litter picking in the area with Mill Hill Residents Association. Form 3 have their trip to Mountfichet – the Anglo Saxon castle trip.

On Friday, children in EYFS and Form 1 who have peripatetic lessons will be performing to parents at 1.30pm.
